



Motorkhana – Winton Skid Pan Club Championship Round #11 Saturday 11th August 2018 Supplementary Regulations

1. AUTHORITY

The Event shall be a **Multi-Club Motorkhana** held under the provisions of the Held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the National Motorkhana Code, The CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the M.G. Car Club Victoria 2018 Competition Rules, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, if issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

3. ENTRIES

1. Entries are open to financial members of the MGCC Melbourne (incl Geelong) who hold a CAMS Level 2NS, L2NSJ licence or superior.
2. Entries will open with the publication of these Regulations and close at the start of the Drivers Briefing on Saturday 11th August 2018
3. The full entry fee shall be \$40, youth \$20
4. Competitor's must bring their own lunches.
5. All entries must be completed on the Official Entry Form accompanied by the Entry Fee.
6. A maximum of 60 entries will be accepted, in order of receipt.
7. The Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

4. THE EVENT

1. The Event will commence at 9.30 am and it is the responsibility of the Competitor to present their car for Scrutiny between 8.30am and 9:15am. Scrutiny will be at the venue.
2. A compulsory Drivers Briefing will be held at 9:15am. Any Driver not attending will be excluded from the Event.
3. All Competitor's will have 2 runs at each course. The fastest of these runs will count towards the final result. The outright and class result will be decided on the lowest total aggregate time for all tests throughout the day.
4. Timing will be by automatic electronic timing to one hundredth of a second, or by hand-held stopwatches. The Timekeepers, observers and garage officials are deemed Judge of Fact for timing and associated penalties incurred on the pattern. In all other matters the Clerk of the Course will act as Judge of Fact.
5. The Event will be conducted at the Winton Raceway Benalla Skid Pan.
6. A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 6 tests will be conducted. All test patterns will be loaded on the MGCC website prior to the Event.
7. Reruns will only be permitted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
8. Classes for this Event will be as per the Entry Form.



5. INSURANCE:

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

6. SCRUTINY

1. All vehicles must comply with the National Motorkhana Code, Schedule A and Group 4H – Motorkhana Cars Regulations as published in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Current club membership, CAMS licence and Log Book (if applicable) must be presented at Scrutiny.
2. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
3. Log Books (if issued) must be presented at Documentation, along with the current CAMS licence and current Car Club membership card.
4. All vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.
5. There is to be no loose objects within the vehicle.
6. All apparel for Competitor's, including Passengers, must comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
7. All vehicles (except for Pre-War cars) must be fitted with a minimum of a lap seat belt in accordance with Schedule I of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

7. PROTESTS:

Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCRs in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

8. ABANDONMENT:

In accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

9. EXCLUSION:

The Clerk of Course may exclude from further competition any Competitor who:

- disobeys the direction of an Official
- Is guilty of inappropriate behaviour
- exceeds 10km/h anywhere except the racing surface including Pit Areas and 'Dummy Grid'

10. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES:

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.

Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

11. PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

- (a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Passengers MUST:
 - i. wear the same protective gear as a Driver
 - ii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
 - iii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer
 - iv. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a passenger.
 - v. Be at least 12 years of age
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.
